*Please note that ALL convertibles (even hard top convertibles) must be equipped with a four point roll cage consisting of a main hoop behind the front seats with two rear braces, and a four (preferably five) point safety harness. The above approved roll cage will be subject to the broomstick/2-inch rule. **The broomstick/2-inch rule** means that when a broomstick is placed from the windshield header across to the main roll-hoop, there must be 2 inches or more of space between the **HELMETED** head of the driver and the bottom of the broomstick. Failure to pass this test means you can't drive this vehicle at an ACNA driver school. Convertibles with only factory roll hoops and/or deployable roll over protection will not be allowed. If you just "show up" with a convertible not in compliance with the above, you will not receive a refund.*

*Targas (such as 911 Targas and Lotus Elises) are not considered convertibles subject to the convertible rules. However, they must comply with the broomstick/2-inch rule, meaning that when a broomstick is placed from the windshield header across to the targa top, there must be 2 inches or more of space between the **HELMETED** head of the driver and the bottom of the broomstick. It is recommended that all targa tops be installed. Failure to pass this test means you can't drive this vehicle at an ACNA driver school. If you just "show up" with a Targa not in compliance with the above, you will not receive a refund.*

All sunroofs must be in the closed position.

No SUVs or SAVs will be allowed.
