Blinker Passing Protocol

ALL Passing at this event is by permission only, using Audi Club's **turn signal** ("blinker") passing methods.

- **Passing is only allowed in the green and red passing zones.**

All groups may use the Green zones. D (Adv) and X/Y/I (instructor) groups may also use the Red zones.

Only the green zones are coned. There will be a green cone at the start of the zone and a yellow cone at the end of the zone. All Zones end at turn-in.

Know your group's zones. Violators will be black flagged.

- **Passing is allowed on either side.**

The car being passed is expected to drive their normal line; the car making the pass is expected to go offline.

- **Passing permission is given by the slower car using their turn signal (blinker).**

A left blinker indicates that you will stay on the left side of the track, and that the passing car is to pass you on your right.

A right blinker indicates that you will stay on the right side of the track, and that the passing car is to pass you on your left.

If you are allowing multiple cars to pass, keep the blinker on until they have passed.

Turning the blinker off indicates that no more passing is permitted.

Be aware that cars without functional turn signals may be using the point-by protocol.

We realize that using blinkers is different from signals used elsewhere.

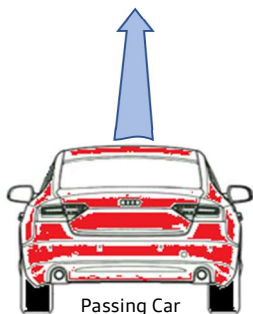
BLINKER Passing Protocol!
