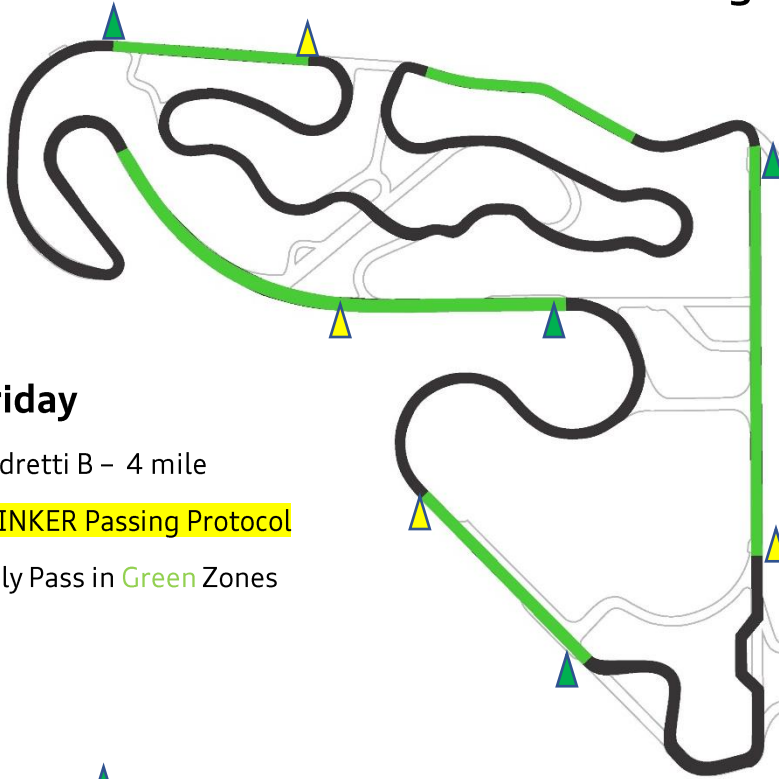


Track Maps with Passing Zones and Audi Club Passing Protocol

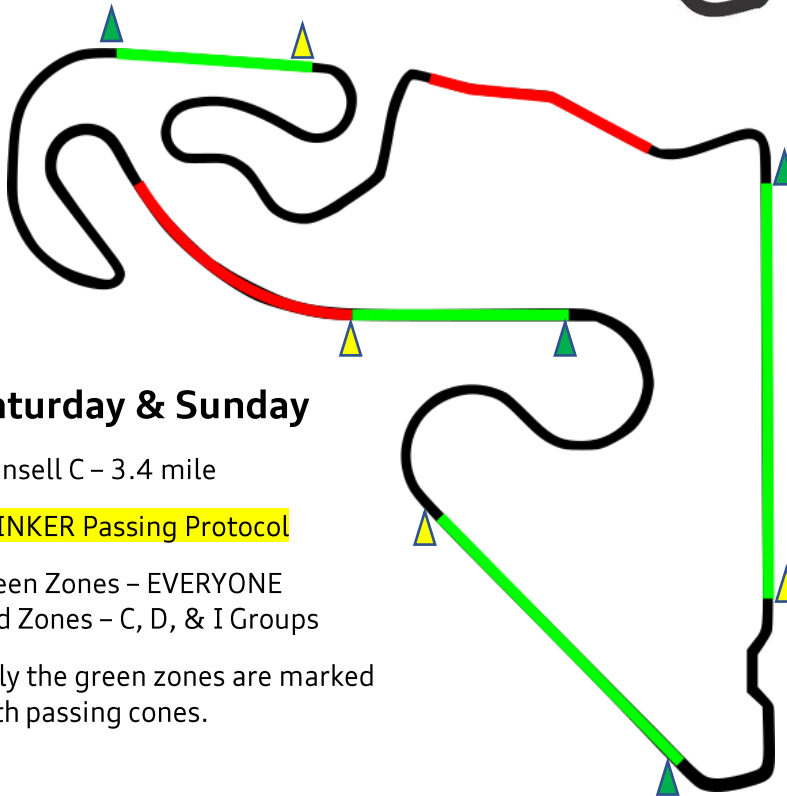


Friday

Andretti B - 4 mile

BLINKER Passing Protocol

Only Pass in Green Zones



Saturday & Sunday

Mansell C - 3.4 mile

BLINKER Passing Protocol

Green Zones - EVERYONE

Red Zones - C, D, & I Groups

Only the green zones are marked with passing cones.

Audi Club Passing Protocol

ALL Passing at this event is by permission only, using Audi Club North America's mandatory turn signal ("blinker") method.

- Passing is only allowed in the green and red passing zones.

Know the zones. Violators will be black flagged.

- Passing is allowed on either side.

The car being passed is expected to drive their normal line; the car making the pass is expected to go offline.

- Passing permission is given by use of the **turn signal (blinker)**.

A left blinker indicates that you will be staying on the left side of the track and that the passing car is to pass on the right side of the track.

A right blinker indicates that you will stay on the right side of the track and that the passing car is to pass on the left.

If you are allowing multiple cars to pass, keep the blinker on until they have passed.

Turning the blinker off indicates that no more passing is permitted.

Be aware that cars without functional blinkers, may be using the point by protocol.
