

Spring Mountain Rules

1. Wristbands must always be worn and visible.
2. No participant may access other areas of the facility unless prior authorization has been given.
3. 5 mph speed limit in the paddock must be obeyed at all times.
4. Stop signs and other traffic signals must be obeyed at all times.
5. The use of blocks or pads is **MANDATORY**. They must be placed under all under jacks, trailers, etc. Spring Mountain Paddock Marshal will supply pads if needed and provide instructions for return at the conclusion of the event.
6. Jack stands with pads must be used whenever any person is under any part of a lifted vehicle.
7. Any vehicles leaking oil, coolant, fuel, or other fluids must have a pan placed underneath to catch the leak.
8. All participants must park properly and adhere to assigned spaces (if applicable) to ensure that everyone will fit in the paddock.
9. For the safety of all participants, walking, riding, or driving beyond cones or barriers surrounding the track is strictly prohibited.
10. Walking, riding, or driving on the track outside of the event times is strictly prohibited (i.e., Bikes, rollerblades, scooters, skateboards, skates, etc.).
11. Testing, cool downs or brake bedding is prohibited on the access roads or in the paddock unless prior authorization has been given.
12. No oil, fuel, or other hazardous liquid may be filled without properly protecting the paddock surface.
13. Any spills must be cleaned with oil dry **IMMEDIATELY**.
14. It is the sole responsibility of participants to dispose of hazardous waste in any way that is environmentally conscious and respectful.
15. All teams are working hard, please respect the space of all participants.
16. All dogs must remain on leash (per Nevada law). Owners must clean up after their dogs.
17. Fire pits and BBQs are permitted if they are properly contained.
18. The use of illegal substances is strictly prohibited.
19. All alcohol consumption is strictly prohibited when the track is hot.
20. The use of drones is prohibited unless prior authorization has been given.
