Before you arrive:

- Tech Inspection: If you have not yet submitted your <u>tech inspection form</u>, please email it to <u>AudiSoCalRegistrar@gmail.com</u> before the event. Once it has been filled out by your Audi Dealer or independent mechanic, sign and email the form.
- **Registration Status:** Check your registration status on <u>MotorsportReg</u>. If your registration status does not show "Confirmed," please check the following:
 - o ACNA membership valid through April 30,204
 - Signed SpeedWaiver liability waiver
 - o If you need help or have questions, email AudiSoCalRegistrar@gmail.com.
- Driver meetings:
 - o First timers meeting: Monday 4/15 7pm PT Zoom link
 - o Instructors meeting: Tuesday 4/16 7pm link will be emailed separately by the CDI
 - All drivers meeting: Wednesday 4/17 7pm PT Zoom link

These meetings are mandatory and we do take attendance. Please use your real name when you log in so we correctly note your participation.

- Review and print track maps and rules:
 - o Friday: 3.23-mile Charleston Peak CW Full Course configuration
 - Saturday & Sunday: 2.63-mile Charleston Peak CW South Course configuration
 - Spring Mountain's Paddock Rules
- DrivingEvals: You will receive a welcome email from DrivingEvals just before the event with the
 name and contact information for your instructor; we encourage you to reach out to each other
 to chat before arriving at the event

Check in:

- Friday drivers and first timers: Check in at the Charleston Peak driver's lounge. First timers should arrive by 1pm on Friday.
 - o Address: Spring Mountain, 4767 S Highway 160, Pahrump, NV 89048
- **Weekend drivers:** Check in Friday evening and meet fellow drivers at our Friday reception. Light dinner will be served.
 - Address: Mountain Falls Golf Club, 5001 Clubhouse Dr, Pahrump, NV 89061
 - If you are driving on Sunday only, you will check in at the Charleston Peak driver's lounge on Saturday afternoon or Sunday morning.
- Bring your driver's license, be prepared to show the SpeedWaiver confirmation on your phone, and bring your tech inspection form if you did not email it in advance



When you arrive:

- You will have to pay \$20 cash gate fee for each person arriving at the track. This is good for the whole weekend, so keep keep the wristband on until the event is over.
- Park/set up in the Upper Paddock (#1 on this map)

Good to know:

- Morning safety briefings: There will be safety briefings each morning—you must attend them to get your wristband to get on the track
- There will be no fuel available at the track; the nearest gas station is about 3.5 miles away in Pahrump
- Food and Drink:
 - Lunch will be provided by the club for the days you are registered to drive; there is no café at the track, so get breakfast before you arrive
 - The club will provide bottled water during the event, but it is wise to bring your own preferred drinks and snacks
 - Alcohol and any other substance which impairs the ability to drive safely <u>may not be</u> <u>used</u> until track driving ends at the conclusion of the day (when the track goes "cold"), whether or not you are done driving early, or if your substance is legal or illegal, over the counter or prescription—this includes use by your non-driving guests
- Helmets must be worn during all skid pad exercises and while driving on track
 - Helmets must be motorsports-specific and rated Snell SA2015, SA2020, or have a current FIA rating
 - Motorcycle helmets are not allowed
- Even if you are not driving on Friday, we welcome you to show up to observe and get a ride on the track with one of our instructors
- Cameras, lap times, and data collection:
 - Cameras and smartphones must be in your pocket or securely mounted while driving;
 handheld devices are not allowed in the car
 - Exterior suction cup cameras require a separate securely attached leash
 - Data collection and in-car video is encouraged for post-session analysis, but lap times or lap timer screens (e.g., Corvette PDR, AiM Solo, etc.) may not be visible to the driver while on the track; if you have this equipment permanently mounted in your car please select an alternate display or hide the display
- Medical Info Emergency medical response will be onsite while driving is underway; all drivers should carry an ICE (In Case of Emergency) card or form on their person while participating in this event
